

Instruction:

1. Game variation for 1 player:

Place the 4 stacks in front of you on the table.

Now draw one card from each pile.

Either from the top or somewhere in the stack. Place them in the correct order in front of you on the table (see above).

Now read the sentence in its entirety.

To doublecheck you can have the Telimero pen read the sentence again.

Now think:

Could it really have been that way, or is that rather nonsensical?

Maybe you'd like to make up a story about that sentence?

You can repeat this as long as you like.

2. Game variation for 2-4 players:

Distribute the cards mixed with the braille lettering up on the table.

Now everybody takes a turn, draws a card and put the card in front of you.

Repeat this process until you can form a whole sentence or until one player completes a sentence.

The player then reads the sentence out loud or the Telimero pen can read it to you.

Now you put the cards of the deck on top of each other and to the side..... and the game goes into the next round.

Who could form the most sentences at the end?
